

Bruce Peninsula Art Show Entry Agreement & Form

Entry form and payment must be received by May 31, 2026

You must be a permanent or seasonal resident of Grey or Bruce County to enter

1. INSURANCE:

- The Bruce Peninsula Art Show committee accepts no responsibility for the loss, damage or destruction by theft, fire, smoke, water or handling, of any artwork entered in the show.
- **Artists are expected to have their own insurance.**

2. ARTWORK:

- All artwork displayed in Gallery I must be originals. Reproductions must be shown in Gallery II. This includes multiples of photographic images. Only one of each image may be hung in Gallery I.
- All work displayed must be registered with the Art Show committee and checked in by a committee volunteer. Any work not properly registered will not be processed for sale.
- Any work not priced or not clearly marked N.F.S. (Not for Sale) will be removed.
- Please note that **no more than two (2) works may be N.F.S.**
- All artwork, in Gallery I and II, must have official Art Show tags and be recorded on official inventory sheets, which will be emailed to you upon confirmation.

3. CONDITIONS OF SALE:

- The Bruce Peninsula Art Show will take a 20% commission on all sales.
- All profits from the show go to the Bursary Fund which supports students in Grey and Bruce Counties that are pursuing their Post Secondary education in the Visual Arts.
- Cheques for artwork sold will be mailed to artists by the end of August.

4. HANGING WORK BEFORE THE SHOW:

- Artists must hang their work on **Thursday, July 30th, between 6 – 9 pm**, or on **Friday, July 31st, between 9am – 12 noon**. There will be no exceptions.
- If you are unable to commit to this schedule for hanging your work, please do not enter the show this year.
- We hope you will be part of the “Meet the Artists” opening on Friday, July 31st from 7 pm – 9 pm.

5. PICKING UP UNSOLD WORK AT END OF SHOW:

- No work may be removed before 5:30 pm on Monday unless sold and taken by the purchaser. There will be no exceptions to this condition.
- All artwork not sold must be picked up by the artist, or person designated by the artist, on **Monday, August 3rd between 5:30 pm and 6:00 pm**. The show will close at 5:00 pm on Monday for final reconciliation. Doors will reopen to Artists at approximately 5:30.
- We are unable to hold any work after 6:30 pm as the display boards are taken down beginning at 6:30 pm.

6. BEHAVIOUR:

- The Bruce Peninsula Art Show has a zero tolerance policy towards disrespectful behaviour. Any artist and/or artist’s helper who is disrespectful of the rules, the volunteers, other artists or visitors to the show, will be barred from future shows.
